### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ATTRACTION

The program takes place on the Tall Ship Kajama, a 165ft three masted gaff-rigged schooner. Launched in 1930 Germany, she was a cargo carrying sailing ship before being delivered trans-Atlantic and restored to her original profile in 2000.

### DESCRIPTION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The Sail Through Time program ties in your schools curriculum to hands on stations on board. The students will assist the crew sailing the ship while raising and lowering the sails. They will partake in water testing, chart reading and calculate water depth and boat speed to name a few examples. The program operates 3 times a day for 1.5 hours.
