Mackenzie House is an 1858 Greek Revival row-house, former home of William Lyon Mackenzie: Rebel, newspaper editor and the first Mayor of Toronto.

Mackenzie House programs offer students a glimpse of the 1860's and the opportunity to visit a working printshop. Program themes include the Rebellion of 1837, Confederation, Victorian daily life, Black History and the power of the press. Several programs offer students hands-on activities in the printshop: typesetting their name and printing a newspaper on the 1845 printing press.
