DESCRIPTION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

This special program has been developed for grades 2 to 8. It involves a day long outing at the park beginning with a 45 minute live educational show. The presentation covers water safety and lifesaving techniques along with boating safety rules. Of course the staff is trained and fully certified.
