Exotic greenery and flowing water create a rainforest-like environment for 2,000 tropical butterflies. Over 40 different species of butterflies fly freely through the 1,022 square metre (11,000 sq.ft.) climate controlled conservatory.

Located at 2405 Niagara Parkway.
