Charlie Cutts has been President and Chief Executive Officer of The Corporation of Massey Hall and Roy Thomson Hall since April 1992.

From 1980 to 1989 Charlie was the General Manager of the O'Keefe Centre for the Performing Arts, now known as the Hummingbird Centre. Prior to that, he was Vice President of Airport Operations for a private hospitality firm, The Bitove Corporation from 1990 to 1992.

Charlie received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in English from the University of Toronto and is a Chartered Accountant by profession, having spent 1969 through 1980 with Clarkson Gordon (now Ernst & Young), and Woods Gordon Management Consultants. He is a past Chairman of the Board of Family Services Association of Toronto, and was a founding director and officer of both the Toronto Entertainment District Association and Canada's Walk of Fame.

Charlie's participation in professional industry associations includes many years of directorship and volunteer officer positions with the International Association of Assembly Managers (IAAM) and the Canadian Arts Presenting Association/l'Association canadienne des organismes artistiques (CAPACOA). Through two terms of directorships, Charlie was Treasurer, Secretary, Executive Committee member and then President in 1999 of the International Society for the Performing Arts (ISPA).

In 2004, Charlie received the Alumni Award from the University of Toronto at Scarborough as part of the 'Great Minds' programme "recognizing outstanding alumni who have made a significant contribution, or achieved considerable success, in their chosen field of endeavour".
